Footfall for the year to date is 7.9% down on the previous year.


The number of visitors counted for week commencing 11 November 2019 was 176,746.

The busiest day in week commencing 11 November 2019 was Saturday with 41,005 visitors.


The peak hour of the week was 13:00 on Saturday 16 November 2019 with footfall of 4,574








Footfall by hour
