The change in footfall for Canterbury City Centre over the last 52 weeks is 12.2% down on the previous year.


Footfall for the year to date is 25.9% down on the previous year.


The number of visitors counted for week commencing 6 April 2020 was 26,795.

The busiest day in week commencing 6 April 2020 was Thursday with 4,426 visitors.


The peak hour of the week was 11:00 on Thursday 9 April 2020 with footfall of 432

Footfall by week Weather











Footfall by hour
