The change in footfall for Canterbury City Centre over the last 52 weeks is 25.4% down on the previous year.


Footfall for the year to date is 48.1% down on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 15 June 2020 was 74,250.


The busiest day in week commencing 15 June 2020 was Saturday with 12,911 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 13:00 on Saturday 20 June 2020 with footfall of 1,708


Footfall by week










Footfall by hour
